Attached at the end of the Newsletter is a letter and form from the Brick Police which is self-explanatory.

#### Dear Neighbor,

The paving of our streets has been completed in time for the Memorial Day weekend. The pavers have done a very nice job.

In addition to the paving, some curbing has been replaced. Other curbing that may not have been considered for replacement but, in our opinion, needed to at least be repaired has been brought to the attention of the Township engineer and we are hopeful that they will do some more work on the curbs.

On Bay Lane, there were sidewalks in front of the homes on the north side of the street, but there was no sidewalk at the lagoon ends. As part of the paving project, the Township installed sidewalks at the lagoon ends so that we now have a continuous sidewalk from Ketch Road to Pointe Drive. This is a big safety improvement and we encourage people to use the sidewalk.

In our Winter Newsletter, we brought up the possibility of changing the configuration of our property between 35N and 35S at the flagpole island. Since Brick notified us shortly after that Newsletter went out that we would need to dedicate the streets in order to get the paving done we stopped looking into the reconfiguration for the time being. We did get Brick to put curbing around the flagpole island and the land to the north and south of the flagpole island.

As you will see elsewhere in this Newsletter, under the Nominating Committee Report, I have agreed to be nominated for the office of President after I said I would not serve again in the Winter Newsletter. I agreed to allow my name to be placed in the nominations because we have two people who are willing to take on the position of President but not until next year. So, if reelected, I will serve just one more year.

It has come to our attention that painting contractors are spilling paint in the streets as they do jobs throughout the Community. If you see anyone spilling paint, please take the name of the company and telephone number and call us with that information ... any Board member can be called.

I posted a notice on our website about the Nor'easter we had on May 12-13, 2008. One of the issues we had to deal with in the aftermath of the storm was trying to find out where the garbage cans that were blown around the neighborhood belonged. Please, if you don't have your house number on your garbage can, please put it on there so that we get the cans back to you the next time we have high wind conditions that the blows the garbage cans around the Community.

Please mark your calendar for these important dates ... **JUNE 29, 2008** for the Association's Annual Meeting and **JUNE 27, 2008** for our Social Event. Details and reservation form for the Cocktail Party will be mailed to you in the next few days.

Lastly, as we ask each year please think of your neighbors ~~~ <u>limit</u> noisy construction work during the summer months and <u>remove</u> all boats from your yards and driveways during the same period.

#### GARBAGE ISSUES

Brick will once again have garbage and recycling trucks behind the firehouse on Saturdays from 8:00 AM until 2:00 PM. The garbage truck in the past has accepted almost anything except paint and flammable liquids.

Normal garbage pick-up is Monday mornings. Brick normally will not pick up leaves, branches, pine cones, needles or other plant refuse that is left at the curb in <u>plastic bags</u>. Some times they will come through, open the plastic bags, take the contents and leave the bags to fly around the Community, and these bags end up in the lagoons. These items should be put in paper bags specifically made for plant refuse.

You should also call the Town's Public Works (732-451-4060) to see when they will be picking up this type of refuse and heavy metal items since they only do it twice a month. Please do not just leave it on the curb as it could stay there for several weeks.

Recycling is usually picked up on Tuesday mornings:

- Bottles, cans and plastic may be mix together
- Newspapers and cardboard must be tied separately
- Recycle mixed paper magazines, catalogs, junk mail are to be put in an untied brown paper bag

Please help keep the Shores clean and respect your neighbors by not leaving items that will not be picked up on the curb week after week.

<u>Construction Material</u> - Brick will not pick up construction material ... If they do find it in your garbage can, they will not empty the receptacle.


## A TRIBUTE TO ELINOR MURPHY


